




MODEL OF ASSESSMENT OF PILOT PERFORMANCE



Perspective and Opinion



- Often, in psychology, a container or bucket is used as a metaphor for what we can "Carry".
- Containers usually are associated with the following attributes:
 - They are regarded as having a finite capacity.
 - They have a requirement to be filled and emptied by someone or something Intentionally.
 - They have to be monitored to ensure that an overflow or empty condition does not occur.
 - Containers can be disrupted by environmental systems and often are less than secure.





- A physical conduit is a contiguous pathway between two assets. However we often see conduit used as a metaphor for communication.
- Conduits usually are associated with the following attributes:
 - Their capacity is determined by the overall system volume, not a single asset.
 - The integrity of the system is sealed protected against most contamination or spillage.
